Good morning all. I apologize for not being able to make the meeting yesterday. I have attached event schedules for both Tournaments and Private Events in the restaurant. I have also included the updates regards to golf course items that are being performed. Please see below additional comments.

1. I am awaiting to hear from City representatives on the time frame for the repair of the cart path leading out to number 1. I will update when I have information.

2. Mark, regarding your question on rules. The main local rule that comes into play here is the lost ball or ball hit out of bounds. I can certainly post a sign stating that for noncompetitive rounds we are invoking the USGA recommended local rule that they proposed. At this time we have scorecards that we will use for at least the next 6 months or more and will not be doing a reprint at this time. It is not cost effective. All other rules changes that occurred are adopted as the Rule of Golf as we know them.

3. As you will see on the schedule we will be punching and sanding the greens at the end of March.

4. We had a meeting with the architect that is assisting us with Michael's. You will continue to see upgrades such as new televisions, digital menu boards and up graded art work as we move forward.

5. Lastly, as you all can imagine the weather has impacted our rounds of golf which obviously will impact revenue. February has been another difficult month in this regard. The good news is that it is benefiting the golf course in many ways. Some of those include not having to irrigate which helps save some of that expense and flushing the salts from the soil which provides and assist in better turf quality.
